The Bodhi Tree and Mahabodhi Temple at Bodh Gaya

The Bodhi Tree, a sacred fig (Ficus religiosa), is where Buddha attained enlightenment. Located in Bodh Gaya, Bihar, this site symbolizes peace, knowledge, and spiritual awakening, attracting pilgrims worldwide. The first temple was built by Emperor Ashoka in the 3rd

century B.C. The current Mahabodhi Temple, built during the 5th or 6th century A.D., is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the earliest brick-built Buddhist temples, showcasing India's early architectural mastery.



Rajgir: The Ancient Capital of Magadha

Rajgir served as the ancient capital of Magadha until the 5th century B.C. under King Udayin, and it later shifted to Pataliputra (modern Patna). The region, rich in history, is now home to modern attractions like the soon-to-be-inaugurated glass bridge.

Spanning 85 feet and accommodating 40 visitors, it will offer breathtaking views of Rajgir's hills, providing an exciting addition to the area's historical allure.



Harappan Artifact in Bihar Museum

Bihar Museum in Patna showcases artifacts from the Harappan Civilization and covers periods from the Mauryas, Nandas, and Shishunagas. The collection spans the 4th to 1st centuries B.C., providing insights into the technological and cultural advancements of ancient India. Notable exhibits include the Didarganj Yakshi and fragments of stupas depicting Buddha's life.



The Ashokan Pillar at Kolhua. Vaishali

The Ashokan Pillar in Kolhua, Vaishali, was built by Emperor Ashoka and stands at 18.3 meters, crowned with a life-size lion figure. This polished

sandstone monument is a significant relic of ancient India, reflecting Ashoka's contributions to Buddhism.



ISKCON Temple, Patna

The ISKCON Temple in Patna is a spiritual center founded under Bhaktivedanta Swami Srila Prabhupada. The temple is a hub of

religious activity, offering Kirtan and Prasadam to visitors. It stands as one of the city's major religious attractions.



Takhat Sri Harimandir Sahib, Patna

The grand tomb of Sher Shah Suri in Sasaram stands as a magnificent example of Indo-Islamic architecture. Built in the 16th century, this sandstone mausoleum, surrounded by an artificial lake, reflects the glory of the Suri dynasty. Sher Shah Suri, the founder of the Suri

Empire, was known for his administrative reforms and for introducing the Grand Trunk Road, which still serves as one of India's major highways. The tomb's intricate carvings, domed roof, and picturesque setting make it a must-visit for history enthusiasts.



Valmikinagar: The Forest of Legends

Valmikinagar, located on the India-Nepal border, is a scenic and spiritual destination known for the Valmiki Tiger Reserve and the Valmiki Ashram, where the sage Valmiki is believed to have written the Ramayana. The area offers breathtaking views of the Gandak

River and is rich in biodiversity, home to Bengal tigers, leopards, and many other species. For nature lovers and spiritual seekers alike, Valmikinagar provides a serene escape amidst natural beauty and historical significance.
